The applicant must be an African-American student currently enrolled in a Vocational and/or Technical School or Program within City of Tampa/Hillsborough County. **The current student must have a current 2.5 GPA or better, current transcript is required.**

Required attachments to the completed including the application and essay:

- **Three (3) references letters. Note letter should be personal and should highlight your contributions and accomplishments in the community. NO computer generated signatures. The letter must contain an original signature on each letter AND the letter must be submitted on letterhead or it will NOT be accepted!**
- **Professional head shot photograph must be submitted with each application. Note: NO cell phone selfies will be accepted.**
- **A sealed and official current transcript.**
- **A student biography of 8 to 10 sentences which highlights your academic accomplishments and explains your personal and future goals for life and your education.**
